

## CM Bruxelles: Inscription ends on February 28

### After Beijing 2018 the prestigious wine competition comes back to Europe: Aigle in Switzerland is host town 2019

February 28 will be deadline for inscriptions for the 26th Concours Mondial de Bruxelles. After Beijing 2018 the CMB this year will take place in the world cycling capital: Aigle. From May 2 – 5 the 350 tasters from more than 50 countries will do their work in the center of the 200-meter-long wooden cycle track in the heart of the Olympic training centre. During the competition, the site will be completely redesigned to guarantee the best tasting conditions. Switzerland's second-largest wine growing Canton, Vaud, is very proud of having been chosen as home of CMB 2019 against strong opponents.

The last years have seen a tremendous rise in participation of Eastern and Central Eastern European wine producers at CMB – for many of them the prestigious competition has become the „entrance door“ to Western markets through the growing number of medals won by wines from Bulgaria and Romania as well as from Moldova, Hungary, Croatia, Slovenia, Serbia, Macedonia, Turkey, Armenia, Georgia, Lebanon and recently from Russia and the Ukraine as well. A lot of tasters from Western Europe, the United States and Asia had to correct their point of view about Eastern wines due to the great qualities coming from there in the meantime – often based on indigenous varieties just a few people knew before. The fact that more than half of the 350 tasters are journalists guarantees global awareness for medal wines, their producers and the countries behind.
